Duration of Matches

The maximum time for a match shall be as follows:

Under 7 to Under 12 Under 13 & Under 14 Under 15, Under 16 & Under 17 Premier League, Raahauge Cup

15 Minutes each way 20 Minutes each way 25 Minutes each way

30 Minutes each way 45 Minutes each way

All games should have equal halves.

In some other competitions (such as knockouts and 6-a-side), special rules very the playing time.

Matches Finishing on Time

& All Age

All sector matches MUST finish on time as other matches may be following and these must kick off on time. If a match commences late, the playing time MUST be reduced to allow the match to finish on time.

Additional time for injury that has occurred during a match is only played in the 3.15pm senior competition matches and in any finals matches as provided by the competition rules (Mainly the 1" grade games in Final Series).

No extra time for injury is played in any other matches, including any Junior competition or knockout match.
