### **KNOCKOUT EXTRA TIME RULES**

### **EXTRA TIME**

At the conclusion of normal playing time if goals are equal the following rules shall apply:

- 1. A maximum period of ten (10) minutes each way shall be played. No half-time break, just straight change of ends.
  - \*\*(Under 8's only 5 minutes each way)\*\*
    [In six-a-side competition only <u>five (5)</u> minute halves].
- 2. During the period of extra time the scorer of the first goal will be declared the winner and the game will conclude at such time.
- 3. If no goals are scored then the team receiving the most corners during this extra time shall be declared the winner.
- 4. If corners are equal or no corners are awarded then the team "scoring" the most goal-kicks during this extra time shall be declared the winner.(A throw-in over the back line does not count as a goal-kick).
- 5. If corners and goal kicks are equal a further & final <u>five (5)</u> minutes only will be played.
- 6. Play for this period will be restarted with a drop ball at the centre of the field. During the final period of extra time the team scoring the first score of any kind being goal, corner or goal kick shall be declared the winner and the game concluded at such time.
- 7. In the unfortunate circumstances that these rules do not obtain a winner a replay of such game will be granted.
