And the same parent waited for the late parent!!

- * parents should not be dropping kids at training or matches and leaving them unattended. It is irresponsible and rude. Child care is not what we offer, it is much more expensive than soccer! Any time you cannot stay parents need to confirm arrangements with another parent that the children will be supervised.
- * older children left unattended are required to behave. Misbehaving teenagers unattended, will be sent home, unattended.
- * Travel to games is the parents' responsibility not the manager's. We have a number of teams with transport difficulties this year and it has already affected results. "I don't know where the ground is" is a totally unacceptable excuse. Other parents, managers and coaches are always happy to arrange for cars to follow them to grounds.
- * coaches please ensure that the start and finish times of training are clear. Finish on time as parents have other things to organise.
- * Sometimes parents cannot stay (especially on a Saturday when they may have a number of kids playing in different teams. Other parents, coaches and managers, please assist these parents (as I know you do.)
- * managers/coaches please inform me of children left unattended regularly.
