A couple of things are concerning the committee at present

- Everybody associated with our club are volunteers, executive, coaches, managers, players, parents. - Setting fields up – if you are the first team on the ground it is YOUR responsibility to set the field up.
- Proof of age – 13s, 14s and 15s are required to give the club a copy of a document proving your age – no POA – no play!

This has taken some strain off the executive (no need to search for players) but has meant numerous players have missed out and some are long standing members who were late. Remember this next year – REGISTER EARLY!
