- 2. Setting up and dismantling fields. Parents this is your responsibility. Children can put flags out, but nets and posts need to be done by adults. Managers and coaches are doing enough already please don't stand back or arrive late or leave early and leave these necessary tasks to others. The newsletter clearly states which teams need to set up and dismantle fields
- 3. Please remember nobody is paid for running this club and its teams. So the work is everybody's responsibility.
