Thanks everyone for a fantastic season. Thanks to the coaches and managers, players and parents. The season finished with a great day at Marconi Stadium yesterday for the President's Cup and Raahauge Cup Grand finals. Unfortunately our 10s and 11s finished second (the 11s losing on count back on corners – so close!), but in McCredie's final game of the year, our RC1 Reserves won 2-1 over Castle Hill in a close contest. A great result.

For those that then hung around for the RC1 final and the Premier League Grand finals they were treated to two of the most exciting games they could have watched.

In the RC 1 final Lidcombe were 3-0 up over Zimwarriors after 15 minutes (something our boys may remember doing to them last year). Again the crowd went nuts in a packed grand stand. Again we had extra time. Wenty's fairytale wasn't over yet and it is Greystanes who still don't have a PL trophy, as Wenty's buildup down the left and a nice cross found their exciting right midfielder for a clinical finish. The crowd went off again — fortunately covering Keith's attempt at announcing the goal scorer's name!
