Six a side next weekend

This coming weekend is the annual six a side tournament.

All our teams have entered to give as many players as possible the chance to participate in what many of us believe is the best weekend of the year. All players are expected to be there unless you have given your coach notice already that you can't be. Players who just don't turn up on the day spoil the day for their whole team and this will be viewed very unfavourably by club management.

We have entered 3 under six teams, 1 under 7, 3 under 8, 2 under 9, 3 under 10, 3 under 11, 2 under 12, 4 under 13, 2 under 14, 1 under 15, 1 under 16 (+ a combined 15/16 team), 1 under 18, 2 AAM, 2 AAL, 1 O35.

Teams play with six players on the field and a maximum of 1 interchange player, some competitions are knockout and some round robin, but every game has a winner (if goals are equal corners are counted, if goals and corners are equal, goal kicks count). Games are 10 minutes each way and played on the same size field you play on every Saturday (except AAL and O35 where the field is $\frac{3}{4}$). Every team will get a minimum of two games but you may play six games in the day depending on the number of entries. Each age will finish with a final and a trophy presentation.

Under 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 will take place on Saturday

Under 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, AAM, O35, AAL will take place on Monday

Please make sure that

- You are on time – the day runs to a tight schedule and being late can cost your team a game.
- You understand the rules
- You bring your training shirt as it is very likely you will play against a McCredie team at some point during the day
- You understand that you may be at the ground for a few hours

Parking around Everley will be chaotic – allow plenty of time and consider parking in Boundary Rd (especially U8s/9s/O35 and AAL)
